

## Education on Sunday Mornings

### Beginners—Ages 3-5

Gather at 9:30am and class begins at 9:45. The children gather with the Elementary group in the worship room on the lower level at 10:30 for a short worship service. Children can be picked up at the conclusion at 10:45.

### Elementary School—K-6th grades

Gather at 9:30am and class begins at 9:45. The children will gather in the worship room on the lower level at 10:30 for a short worship service.

### Confirmation Prep—7th-8th grades

Confirmation is the rite whereby youth join the community of faith, celebrating baptism or affirming the promises made for them at baptism. In our congregation, we celebrate this rite each spring at Pentecost and invite 8th graders to participate. We dedicate both 7th and 8th grade learning experiences in preparation for this commitment. Although we explore a variety of content areas, our primary focus is on building relationships which foster the faith journey. Jeanne Smith is the guide for our Sunday morning learning time.

### Senior High—9th-12th grades

Gather in the Senior High Room at 9:45am to explore a variety of theological topics.

### Fellowship and Fun—Youth Group

All 7th-12th grade youth and their friends are invited to share in our Sunday evening youth fellowship program. Unless otherwise announced, the group meets each Sunday evening from 6pm to 7:30pm.

### Discussion Group
